Forest Green

Recommended items:

[Black Onyx \(pigment\)](#)

[Moss Green \(pigment\)](#)

[Glycerin, Liquid \(Vegetable Derived\)](#)

Instructions:

To achieve a forest green color, we find that using 1 part of Black Onyx to 6 parts of Moss Green gives the nicest color. Add more or less Black Onyx if desired.

Remember that when mixing colors in cold process soap, the raw soap batter has some transparency while the finished bars are opaque. If you find the color of the raw soap too light, it will be lighter in finished bars. We recommend making your raw soap slightly darker than what you want.
